



Dear Parents:

The Elk City Summer Arts Program is about to begin again. This program is offered to your children through The Elk City Arts Council with the help of the United Fund and the Elk City Public Schools. Five programs will be offered again this year including Art, Creative Writing, Drama, Dance and Vocal. This year the classes will be held in the Junior High 7th Grade building and the Susan Powell Auditorium. Vocal classes will be held later in the summer for junior high and high school students by special arrangement. All the other classes will be held June 1 through June 29, Monday through Thursday.

Art, with instructor Stephanie Miller, will be offered from 9-10 a.m. for children from grades 3-6 and 10-11 a.m. for children from grades 1-2.

Creative writing, with instructor Caren Brooks, will be offered from 9-10 a.m. for children who have completed grades 1 and 2 and from 10-11 a.m. for children from grades 3-6.

Drama, with instructor Debbie Sizemore, will be offered to students from grades 1-6 from 11 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Dance will be offered to both boys and girls of all ages from 12:15 to 1:15 p.m..

Fees for classes are determined by the number of children in the family that are attending. One child enrolled in a class would pay \$20 for the summer, per class, two children would be charged \$18 per class, and 3 children would be charged \$15 per class.

Enrollment will be held on Tuesday, May 31 in the hall between the choir room and the Susan Powell Auditorium from 9 to 11 a.m.

All students from the Elk City area are welcome to participate.

We hope you and your children will take advantage of these exciting and enriching programs and have an enjoyable summer.
